## 1. Mr. Otsal Wangdus UNIVER-CITY LADAKH & DIRECTOR OF SEBOL:-

- Invited the guests.
- Briefed the audience that Ladakh Wisdom Forum is organizing this event for the second time in Ladakh.
- Last year IN 2013, We laid the foundation stone of Ladakh Wisdom Forum which involved scholars, thinkers, educationist, journalists, citizens, entrepreneurs, poets e.t.c on the theme

- What is sustainability? Why we need a sustainable community? And what are causes for lack of sustainability.

## 2. Mr. Tashi Morup..... Project Director of LAMO(Ladakh Art and Media Organization):-

 Today Ladakh sown the "<u>SEEDS OF WISDOM</u>" through our friends who have come from a long way "JAPAN".

- As clearly reflected from the teaching of Buddha....Our mind is an embodiment of light/wisdom and all sentient beings possess an inherent wisdom.
- Ladakh is a hub of multi-fold wisdom. Now we must put our wisdom in one's profession, carrier or line of work/occupation we take in our life.
- Ladakhi students are fortunate to learn, debate, discuss, analyse and compare each other's ideas through such seminars/symposium organized in past and now days too.
- To hear & analyse, then contemplate & understand and then at last to put in right action is the crux of wisdom.
- Everyone on this planet is gifted with the SEEDS OF WISDOM.
- Wisdom putting in action is vividly seen today from one
  of our Japanese Guest. A pasted coil on a paper to cook
  food is no doubt a tiny idea but when it comes into
  practice it's so huge, powerful, and sustainable. As such
  every individual can have or generate those ideas &
  wisdom to put into practice and not just simply copy or
  replicating others. So what we need is to cultivate one's
  wisdom.
- So now what is Sustainability?
  - a) It means to protect & care our natural resources for e.g to lead our life on this planet; We are depend on some essential needs or natural resources. So not to destroy this natural resources or extinct it or endanger eco-system is what we call

- sustainability?....the natural resources/ treasures should survive and pass from one generation to next generation which has continued till this date since 1000 years.
- b) However now the way we are exploiting the nature in present time can best be explained through a moral story. For e.g. There was a man with a hen which used to give one golden egg every day but the same man due to his greedy nature killed the hen in order to get the unlimited golden egg and when he killed the hen he found nothing inside the stomach of the hen.
- So wisdom is the education passed by our old generation....viz How we talk, or spend our life as a cultured person.
- So now coming on modernity when mean something like present time:
  - a) To buy consumer goods from market like biscuits, magi, clothes, T.V, radio e.t.c which were completely absent during our traditional moment.
  - b) And when we look back towards our traditional time. We find the clothes made at our own home e.g Nambu, food made from our own natural resources viz..Pa-Ba, Transportation on our domestic animal like horse, ass e.t.c
  - c) Since our traditional time to now, We have been cultivating our farms, water it, using organic products, learning the change of seasons e.t.c
  - d) So in past we had no wastes....means ZERO WASTES in Ladakh. However now we find wastes everywhere.

- Moreover non-biodegrable products had no place in Ladakh.
- e) Traditionally the water we used to face-wash was thrown on a heap of soil and latter the same was thrown in cow-shed for some time to use as manures.... A practical symbol of ZERO-WASTE.
- f) But now the sense of competitiveness has come to Ladakh leading in wastes wherever we go.

# 3. KAGA SKARMA LEY UNIVER-CITY LADAKH & DIRECTOR OF JULLEY LADAKH:

- There are two opinion/thoughts to a foreigner about Ladakh.
- One view is that Ladakh is a self-sustained economy; with harmony, people helping each other, no crooks, followers of truth& spirituality and most important Ladakhis respect & protect nature.
- However the another view is that the ground reality is completely different Ladakh may be like that in past.
- Now days Ladakhis have adopted growth & development (expansion) very positively but when I look the sudden escalation of suicide cases in Ladakh since few years its shocking, similarly the environmental issues and many more. Even now days Ladakhis have strong bonding like family, relative, spiritual essence but the problem of suicide is still growing.
- Use of lots of cement in construction of houses, bridge e.t.c in Ladakh is a warning sign of prone to multi-fold diseases and harm to ecology/environment.
- With the rapid change there is a conflict between internal and external world.
- Japanese now days are working on a line of alternative life-style.
   Like how they spend their life more meaningfully, looking into

- past and some people has seriously working on it now-a-days. The reason for this is the problem of development at a rapid pace it is taking place now days in Japan.
- The growing suicide rates, unable to develop one's mind and lack of co-ordination with-in and out-side are the side-effects of development in Japan.

- He took this wisdom from Ladakh.

   In other parts of world people are homeless but in Ladakh we don't find people without home.
